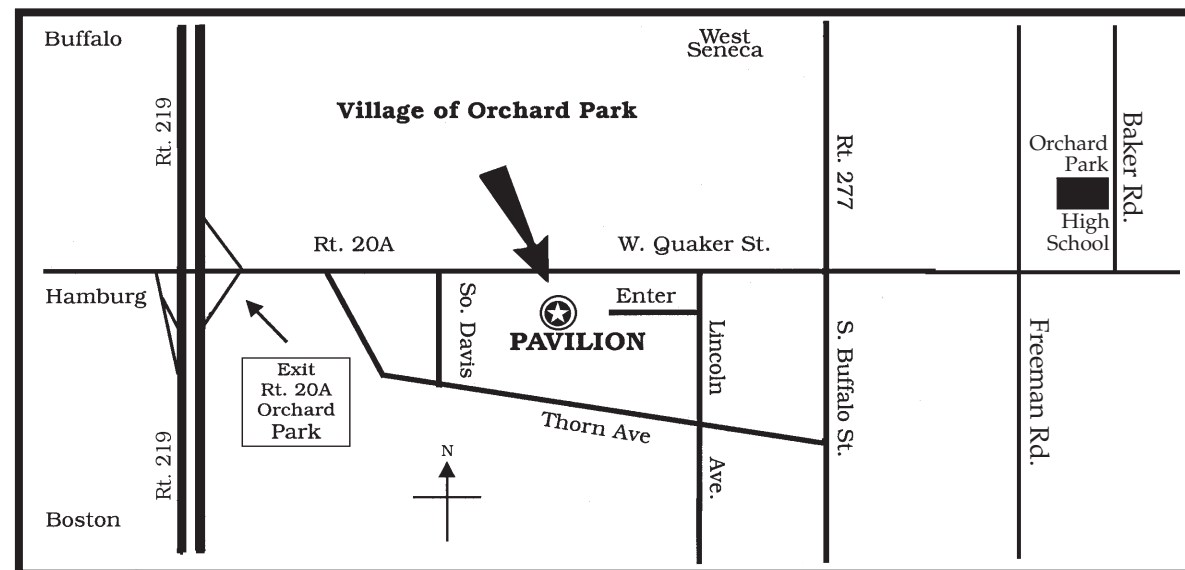


DIRECTIONS TO THE PAVILION



The Pavilion is located behind the Orchard Park Middle School on Lincoln Avenue. There is parking at the Middle School, as well as on the side streets around the Pavilion and behind the Municipal Building on South Buffalo Street, which is only one block away. **Because the Pavilion is on school property, smoking and alcoholic beverages are not permitted.** It IS O.K., of course, to go to the concession stand during the concert!

Access for persons with disabilities is by way of the driveway that runs along the north side of the Pavilion.

Rain will not stop us from enjoying great music. In the event of inclement weather, the concert will take place in the Middle School Auditorium. Up-to-the minute announcements will be posted on the Pavilion Facebook page by 4:30 p.m.
